Most modern books do, but since ISBN numbers have been introduced in the 70s, books older than this period will not have an ISBN number. If they are re-printed nowadays, though, the new edition will be assigned an ISBN number. Note that some e-books do not have an ISBN number. In theory, each edition of an e-book for each reading platform should have its own ISBN number, but some publishers decide not to attribute ISBN numbers to their e-books. ISBN groups.
