Overland Monthly was a monthly magazine based in California, United States, and published in the 19th and 20th centuries. The Overland Monthly was founded in 1868 by Anton Roman, a Bavarian-born bookseller who moved to California during the Gold Rush. He had recently published the poems of Charles Warren Stoddard and a collection of verse by California writers called Outcroppings.
